


## An effective grant application process:

 Allows the foundation to identify and support priority community projects.

 Allows groups to access needed funding to benefit community.



- Transparency
- Clarity
- Simplicity



## Why is an effective grant application process important to your foundation?

- Start at the end Determine your goal.
- Reach out.
- Gather information thoughtfully.
  - What information do you need?
  - What is the best way to get it?



## **Best practices**

- Treat applicants as partners.
- Clear expectations.
- Trust-based philanthropy.
- Consider context.
- Ask for feedback and evaluate.



- Trust.
- Grants align to priorities.
- Accessibility for applicants and streamlined decision-making for the Foundation.


